On the 10th of October a community celebration was held at the Universidad del Este to mark the opening of the exhibition “The Faces of History”. The exhibition includes portraits of three historical figures that are linked to the UNE and to the city of Carolina: Jesús T. Piñero, Ana G. Méndez and Julia de Burgos. The works of art were created by teachers and students of both private and public schools throughout Puerto Rico as part of a contest sponsored by the organization “Autógrafo.tv”, an initiative of People Television. The exhibit includes more than 40 works that evidence the creativity and imagination of the artists. The exhibition will continue in the UNE Library until November 21.

“The Geography of Memory: Canóvanas in the Era of Piñero”

After two years of very intense work, the documentary “Geografía de la memoria: Canóvanas en tiempos de don Jesús” (*The Geography of Memory: Canóvanas in the era of Piñero*) was presented to the public for the first time on October 14th. This documentary is the first film production to be created by the UNE’s Piñero Collection.

The work includes interviews with more than a dozen former and present residents of the town of Canóvanas as well as other individuals who share their experiences in this one-time sugar town during the 1930s, 40s and 50s. The ex governor’s son, José Emilio Piñero, also shares his memories as does architect Otto Reyes who was in charge of the restoration of the Piñero residence in Canóvanas. Historian Juan Giusti, who has done ample research in the study of the sugar economy of Puerto Rico, also contributed to this production.

During the month of October two additional presentations were also carried out. On October 24th, the film was presented at the Universidad del Turabo as part of the yearly assembly of the Puerto Rican Association of Historians (APH), and on October 30th the work was presented at the Piñero House Museum to a public that included many of the men and women who were interviewed for the production. For the creation of this work, the Piñero Collection was fortunate to count on the collaboration of personnel at Piñero House Museum as well as the Municipality of Canóvanas.

The documentary, which has a duration of 40 minutes, includes three basic themes that are related in time: the life of the first Puerto Rican governor, his residence in Canóvanas and the society which was the context for both. The film is a work that reflects both oral history and public history. It is directed toward a non-academic audience, particularly visitors to the Piñero House Museum. With this work it is hoped that visitors to the Museum will have a greater understanding of the wider historical context that gave meaning to Piñero’s work and to daily life in his home.


Book presentations
