Interview with Enrique Mangual Flores
Founder of Empresas Kikuet



He was born in Barrio Cedro of Carolina. At a very young age he began selling peppers in the market places. There he discovered that he had a gift for doing business — creating and selling. This discovery marked the beginning of his life's work, a work which allowed him to establish one of the best known food manufacturers in Puerto Rico — *Kikuet*.

Recently, as part of our Oral History Project, specifically the series "Puerto Rican Businesses", we had the opportunity to interview Mr. Enrique Mangual. In a simple, enthusiastic and spontaneous manner, he recounted for us how this business began in the kitchen of his home and how it has now reached the point where there are more than 400 employees.
